The Idaho Department of Labor and the College of Western Idaho are collaborating to provide enhanced services to school students.

One-Stop Student Services will offer students convenient access to admission and financial aid services, records, student enrichment, skills assessments, résumé writing, interviewing skills, career guidance and labor market information.

The program combining college and labor assistance will begin Nov. 30 at the Canyon County campus, 2407 Caldwell Blvd. in Nampa, and Dec. 1 at the Nampa campus, 5500 E Opportunity Drive in Nampa.

College assistance – admission and financial aid services, records and student enrichment – will be available at both One-Stop Student Services locations Monday through Thursday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

On Tuesdays and Wednesdays, Labor will provide assistance with résumé writing, interviewing skills, career guidance and labor market information. The Labor department representative will be at the Canyon County campus on Tuesday Nov. 30 and at the Nampa campus on Wednesday Dec. 1 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day. The next week the Labor Department representative will be at the Canyon County campus on Wednesday and the Nampa Campus on Tuesday.
